Nomination Procedures for Young Scientist Award

A Letter of Nomination that addresses the following questions :

- Describe the important theoretical and empirical contributions and their impact on the field, usually attributed to the nominee
- What influences has the nominee had on fellow researchers and others in the same field of study

Attach the following :

- A Current Vitae, including Grant Support, Honors, Editorial and other Professional Service, and a complete Bibliography (if not part of the vitae)
- Names and addresses of several scientists familiar with the nominee's work
- A list of ten most significant and representative publications at least three reprints representative of the Nominee's contribution (All material can be submitted electronically, especially reprints.)
